

Civic Committee Monthly Meeting Minutes June 2 | 2015

Attendance: Ed Rohrbach, Al Marks, Bill Theis, Mick Fitzharris and Liz Resko

Meeting commenced at 7: 20 P.M.

Minutes: May minutes approved as presented.

Greens

Civic planted five white rhododendrons at the soldier Memorial. They are planning on planting two special pine trees (20 feet tall, 6 feet wide at maturity).

Miller Rd work completed (three sections on Miller).

Drainage

Miller Rd storm drains: One storm drain definitely needs to be repaired and maybe two others will need repair. Estimate: Restructure concrete \$750 a piece or three drains repaired at \$700 a piece (Little lane and Millers Rd).

Storm water St. Martins Lane: Heavy rains eventually flow into drain but it run down the road. Suggestion: Clean side of road (left side/north) where weeds interfere with flow of water. Not a material difference. A motion was made to clean ST. Martin's road to facilitate water flow.

Curtis Bridge (bridge connecting Arden (Meadow Lane) to Ardencroft (Sunset Lane). Apron needs to be repaired. Looks like a truck similar to our trash trucks backed up to it. Check with Tom to see if Village insurance covers repairs. Estimated cost \$4,000 or to rebuild \$9,000.

Water seepage into man hole is still work-in-progress.

Drainage at Field Theater: It is draining but not fast enough because of 90 degree turns interfere with snaking drain.

Rodney Jester cut down a sixty year old rhododendron that was on town property. He offered to correct and make whole. Civic Committee asks Bill and Rodney to decide on remedy that would satisfying "wholeness" and will invite Forest committee for planting advice.
