Bulletin board for the BWVC. Al will talk with Jeff about whose budget the expense will be charged.

Trimming of trees over road ways - Ed is working on it.

Field Theater fence – Section of fence behind the stage to be raised 2 feet. Motorhome distracts from the play and this would cover it.
