

The regular meeting of the Town Assembly of Arcden was held on January 25, 1960 with Trustee Waeke presiding.

After a quorum was declared present the minutes of the September meeting were read and approved.

The financial report of the Trustees was read and a copy is on file.

Mr Waeke reported that Mr. Sellegman, Mr. Cabri and he had met with attorney for Levy Court and they had worked on a plan that should be acceptable to Levy Court in regards to sewers. Mr Waeke suggested that the

Town Assembly send a resolution requesting immediate action on our petition for sewers.

A copy of this resolution was sent to the Levy Court and to Mr Cabri. Mr Waeke drafted the resolution and the decision to send it to the Levy Court was passed unanimously.

Arise Committee report made by Mr Willson outlined the work in progress. The Arise Committee sent a request to all residents to pick up the roads to keep sides of roads free of debris and to refrain from burning rubbish on the roads. The Arise Committee met with Mr. Richard Darsie of the University of Delaware to get some suggestions as to best handle mosquito control. Legu Tanywal Arsten Stearns will get in touch with mosquito control division of the State Highway Department to enlist their help.

Assessors are reorganizing. No report Community Planning Committee - the deal street pollution open sewers, condition of trees and have conferred with proper

committees in charge of these matters
The committee feels that closely built
communities surrounding Arden will have
an impact on Arden life in recreation
areas, water supply, taxes, schools etc and
they plan to study these matters
