

The regular meeting of the Town Assembly was held on Monday, June 23, 1952 at the Guild Hall with Trustee Wain presiding.

After a quorum was declared present the minutes of the March meeting were read and approved.

The secretary read the three month report of expenditures of the Trustees from March 25 to June 23, 1952 and the annual report for the year ending March 25, 1952. These reports were accepted and copies are filed.

Mr. Worrell reported for the Civic Committee. Several sewage systems have been tested and most of those overflowing have been corrected or the work has been ordered. Mr. Cahalan is sending an engineer to stake out the work on Fire Lane so that it will carry off the water from the Marsh Road that is overflowing on the Thomas, Kay, and Stevenson properties. The work at the Pool was delayed because of inclement weather and the illness of Mr. Vanderer. Therefore, the opening of the pool was not until four days after the planned opening of June 15. In order to get some of the rocks removed from the pool we had to call on volunteer help and the following aided in this project: G. Worrell, Olan Vih, Frank Starr, Ashe ~~Burshell~~ Burshell, James Stein, Albee Williams, and Roy Bloomingdale. The financial report of the Civic Committee for the period ending March 25, 1952 was read and motion the report of the Civic Committee was accepted.

No report from the following Committees: Budget, Community Planning, By Laws Committee.

Assessor reported they were working on the problem of the assessment report due in July and that two open meetings would be

announced by card.

Registration Committee reported 418 voters.  
 Advisory Committee report was given by the secretary in the absence of the chairman. Most of the report was covered by the Committee reports. Most of the discussion at the meeting held on June 17 was about the water situation.

Safety Committee: Mr. Burdick felt that a new safety committee with new ideas and enthusiasms might act more effectively, therefore he resigned. After thanking Mr. Burdick for the work that the Committee had accomplished a motion was made and passed to accept his suggestion that a new committee be elected.

Under old business Mr. Ware announced that the following people had consented to serve on a committee to draw up a letter of remembrance to the families of those residents of the town who had died in the past year and also a testimonial to Harry Vandever for the work he has contributed to the welfare of the town. The Committee consists of Cecil Liberman, Gilbert Worrell and H. L. Ware. It has been planned to hold a testimonial vesper in honor of Mr. Vandever.

School Trustees no report.

ACKA reported that they feel that they will reach the goal of 1400 in their contribution drive and that there are more children than ever enrolled in the activities.

Nominations were received for the Auditing Committee. The following were nominated: Harold Lesher, Samuel Freeman, Robert City. The secretary was instructed to cast the ballot electing this committee.

The Registration Committee was nominated at the March meeting but Mrs. Ruth Warrell requested that her name be withdrawn. The following people had been nominated:

Robert Voss, Virginia Williams, and William May. A motion was made and passed that nomination would be accepted from the floor and the following person was nominated.

The Registration Committee conducted the election and reported the following people elected: Robert Voss, Frank Starr, and Virginia Williams.

The following people were nominated to fill out Carl Messinger's term on the Budget Committee: Richard Dolmetsch, Oliver Hahn, Myron Emanuel.

The Registration Committee conducted the election and report Richard Dolmetsch elected.

The following were nominated to the Community Planning Committee to be elected in July: Edith Ware and Clifford Shedd.

The following were nominated to the Safety Committee: Kenneth Albaugh, Myron Emanuel, Oliver Hahn, Frank Carroll, and Morris Rosen. The secretary was instructed to cast the ballot electing this committee. Oliver Hahn was asked to act as temporary chairman and call the group together. A motion the meeting adjourned.
