

The regular meeting of the Town Assembly was held on March 24, 1958 with Trustee Ware presiding.

After a quorum was declared present the minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

Two letters from Governor Boyce were received acknowledging our concern about the curtailment of school funds and the sale of river bottom land to Colorado Fuel and Iron.

The financial report of the Trustees was read and approved.

Mr. Albert Williams gave the financial report of the Civic Committee. An unexpended balance of \$178.46 from the 1957-58 budget will go into the Trustee fund. Work that would have used the money could not be done because of the cold wet weather during the winter months.

New swimming pool regulations were reported:

- 1- Garden Ardenton resident badges raised from \$2 to \$3. ~~Card~~ guest badges from \$5 to \$6.
- 2- Badges must be purchased before using the pool.

- 3- Badges must be worn at all times.

- 4- Plan to hire Eric Smith + Vincent Mc Gee as guards.

There was some discussion concerning the price of badges. Some felt guest badges should be \$6 and restricted to two per family.

It was also felt that daily guest privileges should be \$15 per swim. Others felt these charges would impose a hardship on the residents of the two communities. It was finally left to the discretion of the Civic Committee to handle the matter.

The report was adopted.

 and Mrs. Wain hopes the town residents will
 help replant them.

Safety Committee requests that another member
 be added to the committee. They are going to
 ask the State Police to more carefully patrol
 Harney Road to check speeding.
