

The recessed meeting of the March 27, 1967
Town Assembly and Commissioners of the Village
of Arden was reconvened on May 7, 1967
with Trustee Wain presiding.

Mr. Shaul Gladstone, Chairman of
the Safety Committee had prepared a summary of
the Safety Code prepared by his Committee. Copies
of the summary were circulated.

A motion was made and passed to review the
summary rather than the entire code.

The general regulations were discussed
item by item.

1- Safety Committee will formulate all further
rules, subject to approval and/or amendment by
Town Assembly.

The rules are not contrary to the Delaware
Motor Vehicle code but all the Delaware
rules are not included.

2- No jail terms are provided. All penalties are
in the form of fines. ~~Further~~ All violators
are reported to the nearest magistrate.

3- Fines for failure to answer summons -
1st offense \$5 to \$15. Subsequent \$15 to \$25

Summons fine come to Village of Arden.
Court cost goes to Magistrate.

4- Bond consists of maximum fine plus cost.

5- Attempt to evade arrest - 1st offense \$50

Subsequent offense \$100 to \$500.

6- Speeding - 1st offense \$25. Subsequent
offense \$25 to \$100 within two year limit.

The speeding offense will go on person record.

7- Reckless driving - first offense \$25.

Subsequent offense \$25 to \$100 for a two year
limit. These offenses will go on person record.

8. Intoxicated Driving - 1st offense \$50 to \$100
Subsequent offense \$100 to \$200.

Mr. Finkelstein stated that Delaware Motor Vehicle Code sets fine at \$200 and loss of driver's license for stated period.

A motion was made and passed that penalties for intoxicated driving conform to Delaware State Motor Vehicle Code.

9. Parking violation - Fines range from \$3 to \$25.

10. Heavy scene of accident involving injury or death - fines \$100 to \$1000.

11. Miscellaneous - horns, go carts will be illegal

First violation \$10-50 Subsequent \$20 + \$10 (1 year limit)

12. Equipment violation. Brakes etc. First \$10-50
Subsequent \$20-75

13. Equipment violation other. First \$5 + \$15 Subsequent \$20-75

14. Equipment violation Lights. \$5-15

15. Obstruction in school buses - \$10 + \$25

16. Searching vehicle contents - First \$5 to \$15 subsequent \$15-25

17. Unauthorized use of or damage to a motor vehicle - First \$50-100 Subsequent \$100-200

A motion was made and passed that the first reading of the Safety Committee's Safety Code is approved as amended.

The nomination was made for the Safety Committee. Shaul Gladstone reported that Mary Baker would not be able to serve again. The following were nominated: Shaul Gladstone, Richard Downes, Louis Bean, Frank Albertson, June Kleban. The secretary was instructed to cast a ballot electing the unanimously.

The problem of rubbish collection was discussed under Good + Welfare. The community cannot do anything about the question and it was suggested that those that preferred to sign up with Crescom do so and see if enough would change to his service to make it profitable for him to come into Arden.

The meeting on motion adjourned.
