

The August 6, 1945, Special Meeting of the Town Assembly of Arden, Delaware.

The meeting was held at Guild Hall, Arden, Delaware, and was presided over by Trustee Ware.

The Chairman declared a quorum to be present and then stated that the special meeting was called for the purpose of electing a committee of five members to confer with the Trustees of Arden in regard to selecting a suitable nominee for the present vacancy on the Board of Trustees of Arden.

The Chairman asked for nominations to the committee.

Ingeborg Stephens moved that the election be conducted by the Hare system of proportional representation. The motion was seconded and approved.

 his vote when his name  
 was called. Upon completion  
 of the balloting the Registration  
 Committee retired to tally the
