During the discussion, it was found that most of the residents at the meeting had Hope's Suburban Garbage. Those that used SonAire were pleased with the service.

Most felt that we should contract for behind the house service in order to correct the untidy way the village looked with cans on the curb side. By having only one trash collector in the Village, it will be easier to correct any problems that arise.

A motion was made that the Town Assembly accept the bid from Hope's Suburban Garbage for twice a week collection behind the house. Eight bags of lawn and garden trash must be at the end of the drive way. There will be a cleanup period for all large and small items for Spring and Fall. Motion passed with 32 ayes and 2 nays.

The collection will begin on January 1, 1979 and a letter will be sent to residents outlining the details.

The meeting on motion adjourned.
