Ordinance - #5 Noise Adopted September, 1970

Section 1. Purpose. The residents of Arden wish to maintain the Village of Arden as a quiet place and to insure their freedom to enjoy a quiet environment. It shall be unlawful for any person to commit any of the following acts:

Section 2. Generally. No person shall create or permit to be created any unreasonably loud, disturbing and unnecessary noise in the village or noise of such character, intensity and duration as to be detrimental to the life and health of any person or to unreasonably disturb or annoy the quiet, comfort or repose of any person. The enumeration hereinafter of certain specific offenses shall not be construed as a limitation of the scope of this paragraph.

Section 3. Motor Vehicle Mufflers, Etc. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in such a manner as to cause excessive noise. No person shall operate a motor vehicle, the brakes or mufflers or other parts of which are in such a state of disrepair or maladjustment as to allow excessive noise.

Section 4. Radios, Phonographs, Orchestras, Dogs, Etc. No individual or group of persons or a band or orchestra shall play musical instruments or a radio, or phonograph, television receiver or other device in the Village in such volume as to cause excessive or unreasonable noise. No person shall allow an unattended dog outside of it's owner's domicile to bark between the hours of 10 P.M. and 10 A.M.

Section 5. Violations. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100. Each instance of violation shall be considered a separate offense.
