

## **Ordinance - #6**

### **Excavations in Village Roads**

**Adopted June, 1972**

Section 1. Purpose To provide for an acceptable standard of road restoration in cases requiring excavation through or into the roads of the Village. This ordinance shall apply equally to public agencies, public utilities, private contractors, leaseholders and/or residents .

Section 2. **(Amended January 1971)** Road Excavation Permit. All excavations in Village roads, regardless of the nature, requiring the prior issuance of a Road Excavation Permit, obtainable from the Village Treasurer with payment of a fee to be determined by the Civic Committee with the consent of the Town Assembly.

Section 3. Road Restoration Details. The details of road restoration, as approved by the Civic Committee, shall be stated on the Road Excavation Permit together with the necessary notification for inspection of work.

Section 4. Emergency Excavations. The only exception to the required prior issuance of the Road Excavation Permit is in the case of an emergency, in which case the permit must be obtained prior to refilling and resurfacing, but in no event more than 72 hours after the emergency excavation.

Section 5. Violation. It shall be unlawful to permit or cause excavation in this Village of Arden without adherence to the provisions of Section 1 through 4 of this Ordinance. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100. Each day such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. In lieu of the fine the offending party shall be liable to the reopening of the excavation for proper inspection and resurfacing in accordance with the provision of this Ordinance.
