

## Safety Committee Meeting 5/10/17

### Minutes:

The minutes for April are approved.

Chris will endeavor to forward past meeting minutes to the Village secretary.

### Sign Installation

John, Chris, Brooke, Tiernan and Leannan installed four signs at Orleans and the top of the highway Sherwood side.

John will check with Miss Utility for signs for the top of the Green and at the fire lane.

### Parking:

The Plymier leasehold is still an issue.

### Dogs:

Steve reported on his research into the dog license issue. There is no dog census for Arden. Previously the counties were licensing dogs but this is now consolidated into the state Animal Welfare department. There is no downside to not registering so most dogs are not. The system is complaint driven.

The committee will ask for a voluntary dog census and will encourage people to register. Steve and Brooke will work with Arden media to teach people how to register and explain why it's important. We can ask for a note to be added to the welcome package.

### ADA:

Brooke spoke to the state ADA coordinator. The Village is at risk for a judgement. Work on the Field Theater crosswalk may require changes to Patros Path. There is no handicapped parking. A space near the Museum would be a good start. The Village should have an ADA coordinator, perhaps sponsored by Safety. This is a topic for the next Advisory meeting.

### Trees:

Larry Walker has a proposal to use Shroeder money to remove trees that affect visibility at certain intersections even though they are on leaseholds. The Trustees would also have money available for this work. Larry did not attend the meeting so we tabled this topic for later.

### Crime:

There have been two recent police chases through town. People are urged to lock up including outbuildings. Brooke will put a piece in the Page.
