

Tree Removal Request Form

There is no need to fill out a Tree Removal Request Form if your tree is 18" in diameter or less.

Please fill out two copies of this form. Return both copies to the Trustee's office. The request will be handled by one of the trustees who will be contacting you.

If a leaseholder has a Tulip Poplar and you want it removed, please know that the Trustees will give you permission to do so. We are concerned that many of these trees are 100' tall, that they are aging, and that they are shallow rooted. When these trees fall, they can cause extensive damage.

Please contact Elizabeth Varley for permission to do so.

If the tree(s) to be removed is (are) within two feet of your neighbor's leasehold boundary, you must indicate that both leaseholders agree on the tree(s)'s leasehold location by your initials here: _____ and your neighbor's initials here:
