

# TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION in the ARDENS

4/1/2018

**It's free!\* It includes yard waste. And you don't have to sign up.**

\* included in land rent for Arden, Ardentown & Ardencroft

**Ardens trash pickup, Recycling & yard waste pickup every Tuesday morning.** Place at curb the night before.

**Yard waste may not be mixed with regular trash.**

Pickup may be delayed due to holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas.

**Single-stream RECYCLABLES** Use your large green can with the yellow lid. All items must be clean and dry.

Paper <i>Must be clean and dry</i>	Newspapers, brown paper bags Printer & copier paper; other office paper Mail, envelopes Phone books, soft cover books Catalogs, magazines	Wax paper Tissues Paper towels Shredded paper
Cardboard & paperboard <i>Must be clean and dry</i>	Corrugated cardboard • Cereal boxes Milk & juice cartons OK if rinsed; remove plastic lid Pizza boxes OK, as long as no food remains; grease OK	Pizza boxes with food debris
Glass <i>Must be clean and dry</i>	Any color bottles or jars Metal rings on bottle necks OK	Mirrors • Window & auto glass Ceramics, porcelain Glass cookware & bakeware
Metal cans <i>Must be clean and dry</i>	Tin, steel, aluminum cans	Cooking pots Aerosol cans Clothes hangers
Plastic	<b>Recyclable plastics</b> numbered <b>1, 2, 4, 5</b> or <b>7</b> Detergent bottles OK if rinsed. Leave small caps on bottles: loose caps can clog sorting equipment.	Motor oil or antifreeze containers Keurig K-cups Plastic bags

**YARD WASTE** Grass clippings, leaves, other yard waste. Do not mix with other recyclables.

Place in plastic bags, or place loose in a trash can or wheeled cart labeled "yard waste," or bundle with string,

Small limbs up to 4" in diameter, cut to max. length 4-feet, tied into a collectible bundle

Please cut thorny branches into small pieces and place in a closed bag for the safety of the collectors.
