Revised Drafts and Approval of minutes from past meetings still pending.  
The Minutes for the November 2019 Meeting were approved with one change:  
The CPC Mission sub-committee are not presenting suggested changes at January 27, 2020 meeting of Town Assembly.

Public gathering to discuss Parking Policy was changed from December.

The Mission of Community Planning – This matter was discussed, and the sub-committee will meet on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month to establish a process and suggested changes in the Mission of CPC.

The Ad Hoc Transformation Committee update was given by Debbie Ricard. Website questionnaire results were reported, and it was noted that Debbie would send the results to the page for publication. The position that CPC supports the refreshed website and approves of the village working with the Government Information Center (G.I.C.) to facilitate the update. This will be stated at Advisory Committee meeting on January 6, 2020 and taken to Town Meeting on January 27, 2020.

It was agreed that Ad Hoc Transformation Committee could move forward with plans for two Informational meetings on Governance. The two meetings have been set for February 9, 2020 and March 14, 2020 in the Buzz. The Ad Hoc Committee was asked to postpone publicizing the meetings until our name and mission was revised and or clarified. The first Informational, Public Meeting (February 9<sup>th</sup>) will be focused on the definition and mission of Village Committees and their responsibilities. The second will be held on March 14<sup>th</sup> in Buzz and will be a “Meet the Candidates” providing the opportunity for Candidates for Committees to introduce themselves and take questions.

Recruitment for Community Planning Committee: There will be two expired terms in March Elections - Mark Wood and Rick Farrell’s terms expire.

There was a request from Tinkergarten and their desire to hold classes for children on the Green. The proposal or request seemed undefined and as did the organization. It was recommended that this request be passed on to the Buzz Ware Community Center.

Information on Vacant Housing will come to CPC at next meeting.
