

The reconvened June Town Assembly was held on September 15, 1961.

The report of the Assessors had been tabled at the reconvened June Town Assembly of September 14, 1961.

A motion was made and passed to move the Assessors report from the table.

The Assessors reported that the factors for roads, commons and forest remained the same.

The base rate is 6.75 per 100 sq. feet of land plus the prorated share of each Assessor based upon the assessment for sewers. This prorated share will be determined by Board of Assessors at a joint meeting with the Trustees of Arden and the Arden Water Sewage Committee. This share will be a sewer factor for each private or commercial unit plus a rate in addition to the base rate for 100 sq. feet.

There was considerable discussion concerning the sewer factor. Mr. Cohen felt it would be illegal. Mrs. Aughey pointed out that this factor was part of the acceptance of sewers in Arden voted on by residents and that it had been accepted as legal by Mr. Corn, the attorney that checked the petition.

A motion was made that the report be reported as it did not conform to

the Board of Trustees on the single tax system
 The motion was declared out of
 order as the Assessor report can
 only be received not accepted or
 rejected.

A motion was made that the
 report of the Board of Assessors be
 received. This was passed.

Mr. Cohen pointed out that the
 legality of the sewer pits could be
 checked when the Assessors met with
 the Trustees and the Water Sewer
 Committee.

On motion the Free Town
 Assembly was adjourned.
