

The recessed meeting of the Town Assembly was held on June 29, 1957. Mr. Walter Wain was presiding.

After a quorum was declared present Mr. Wain introduced Mr. Herbert Coburn who had been retained by the Trustees to contact the City Court and set up a procedure to have sewers in Arden. Mr. Coburn presented a complete report of his action and suggestions as to how to start work with the City Court. A copy of Mr. Coburn's report is on file.

Inasmuch as we have already had two petitions signed by a majority of the leaseholders requesting connection with the Naamouh Soudway district we do not have to prepare another voting on the issue. It was pointed out that ~~the~~ Arden is held as a Trust and the lord's leased the leaseholders and residents cannot have all the privileges of a freeholder. In the question of the payment of the front footage charge, the freeholder has five years to pay this indebtedness but anyone in Arden desiring to connect with the sewers will have to pay this amount in cash before he can connect.

The procedure to be followed is to send a certified copy of the attached resolution to the City Court.

The resolution was unanimously adopted.

A standing vote of thanks was given to Mr. Coburn for his efforts in speeding up action on getting a sewer system in Arden.
