Reviewed two quotes for pruning three (3) damaged Elm Trees and planting a new one. Voted unanimously to select Bartlett's proposal for pruning to be done now and the new tree planted in the fall.

Ask them if they can get Princeton or Morton Cultivar.

Grass cutting. Brandywine Landscaping said it would reflect badly on them to not trim around trees. Discussed putting chicken wire around the bases to stop them. We will still have to address weeding. Discussed doing an Adopt-A-Tree program and putting it in the Arden Page.

Ed & Carol confirmed that all of the newly planted trees are being watered.

Fixed potholes on Orleans & Harvey. Repaired the drain on Orleans & Harvey. Fixed the water flow issue on Mill. Fixed the hole on Meadow & Harvey. The state will fix the intersection of Marsh & Harvey.

Will hold off on putting fence on the Sherwood Green. The Gild will tie ribbon to prevent traffic from exiting from the back.

Motion to install One bench, 6' – 8', at the school bus stop and One, 6' – 8' bench, at the Walt Whitman memorial with a cost not to exceed \$2,000.
