The committee approved the September minutes.

Election:

Brooke, Steve T. and Chris agreed to run again

Deldot:

Deldot agrees that the Harvey Road verge is in our jurisdiction but are confused about Marsh Road. They took a resident's temporary sign from the verge. Brooke called Deldot and got it back.

Harvey-Marsh intersection:

Senator Cloutier has received complaints about this dangerous intersection. We should install 5-way intersection signs.

Traffic calming:

Carol Larson talked to Brooke about planted triangles to manage rainwater runoff while providing a buffer at the crosswalks.

Signs:

Chris will put in a sign order.

John has engaged A. J. Lipstein to put up signs. We should contract ahead to avoid payment problems.

We need to make an inventory of current signs.

Problem leasehold:

Brooke has received numerous complaints of a large tow truck parked on the north side of Orleans. NCC code does not allow large trucks to park in a residential area. Brooke will discuss with the community policing contact.

John will discuss the problem with Holly Oak.

Problem leasehold 2:

The owner of the former Seminick property is planning to install a driveway that enters a five-way intersection. Town meeting had formerly established a parking pad location for that leasehold. The trustees are not interested in intervening. Should this go to town meeting? Is it legal under NCC code?

Public land:

Public land in the village belongs to the town, not the trustees. The change was made in 1971.

Budget:

We have spent \$1088 of the \$3400 budget.
