TRASH & RECYLING COLLECTION in the ARDENS

It's free!* It includes yard waste. And you don't have to sign up.

Ardens trash pickup & yard waste pickup every Tuesday morning. Ardens recycling pickup <u>every other</u> Tuesday morning.

Place at curb the night before. Yard waste may not be mixed with regular trash.

Pickup may be delayed due to holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas.

Single-stream RECYCLABLES Use large green can with yellow lid. All items must be clean & dry. **NO plastic bags.**

YARD WASTE Grass clippings, leaves, other yard waste. Do not mix with other recyclables.

Place in plastic bags, or place loose in a trash can or wheeled cart labeled "yard waste," or bundle with string, Small limbs up to 4" in diameter, cut to max. length 4-feet, tied into a collectible bundle

Please cut thorny branches into small pieces and place in a closed bag for the safety of the collectors.

Trash & Recycling collection in the Ardens is handled by Waste Management.
