Tree Service

Green from their equipment.

The pit for the water meter in front of the Buzz Ware has been
repaired by Downing.

Tom investigated disease resistant elm trees but has not
found a source.

Civic committee will request that the Trustees of Arden supply copies
of legal descriptions of the old Renzetti leasehold and leaseholds
bordering the right of way leading to it to Don Elrod of AES (surveyor),
to see if he can determine where the actual r.o.w. should be located.

Civic has a quote from Turf Management Inc. to aerate the Green (\$1845.00)
also a quote to aerate and overseed the area used for parking on the Sherwood
Green (\$845.00 + \$595.00) We have asked the Gild Hall to share the cost
for the Sherwood Green. Civic would have the work done in the fall after
the Arden Fair.
