Gardener/Steward agrees to:

- 1. Participate in overall garden maintenance above & beyond your assigned plot. Could include weeding, watering & de-bugging community plots, compost care, weeding central area and along fence, trash removal or other general maintenance as needed. Volunteers may choose to take responsibility for specific tasks.
- 2. Keep plots reasonably free of weeds and bugs at all times.
- 3. Keep walkways open and weeded.
- 4. Plant in such a way that crops will not extend into walkways or shade a neighbor's lot.
- 5. Clean plots of all vegetation in excess of 6 inches by November 30.
- 6. Use **only** organic products (including no chemical pesticides or insecticides).
- 7. Stewards will be notified if their assigned plot has not been planted by May 1st, are weedy, or do not meet the guidelines. Failure to respond within 7 days will result in forfeiture of the plot.
- 8. Unattended watering is not permitted. Make sure all faucets are off when you leave the garden. Keep hoses neatly rolled up. Return the municipal water key to the proper storage area.
- 9. Compost in an appropriate manner.
 - a. All switch grass and invasive weeds must be bagged and thrown away
 - b. Vegetable materials can be composted. Compost site is located on the southeast side along the fence near the rain barrels. Please cut material into small manageable pieces (6-inch pieces are ideal).
- 10. Peace and Enjoyment: Gardner agrees not to hamper, disturb or interfere with the space or belongings of another, nor create any nuisances that would affect the peace & enjoyment of others.

The Garden Reps will:

- 1. Assign plots for usage beginning in March, schedule garden activities, and monitor volunteers.
- 2. Plan and stake out plots and raised beds. Meet with community planning committee.
- 3. Reserve the right to withhold renewals from those who did not follow guidelines and/or pass season end inspection. Garden Reps will work with gardeners in case of any extenuating circumstances.
